

Cotton Spice Simplicity BOM Quilt

Block: *Goose Around*

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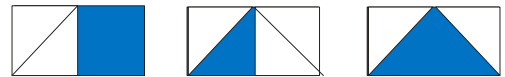
Fabric Cutting

Print	cut 1 4-1/2" square
Green	cut 2 1-1/2"x7" strips
Gold	cut 2 1-1/2"x7" strips
Blue	cut 8 1-1/2"x2-1/2" units
Purple	cut 8 1-1/2"x2-1/2" units
Bkg	cut 32 1-1/2" squares

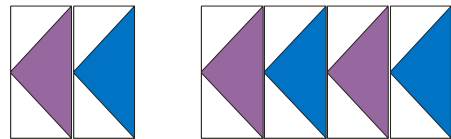
Directions

1. *Creating Flying Geese:* Mark the diagonal on the wrong side of the 1-1/2" squares of Bkg fabric. Match a 1-1/2" square to one end of each of the Blue and Purple rectangles as shown...stitch one thread to the corner side of the diagonal line...press open toward corner. Repeat with other corner ...stitching in direction shown. Turn the rectangle unit over so that the **WRONG** side is up...square up to

1-1/2"x2-1/2" using the original rectangle as your base, and trimming as needed. Trim back extra layers on corners.



2. Attach a Blue Goose to a Purple Goose as shown, pressing toward flat end of Goose. Then, join 2 units to create 4 Goose units as shown, pressing toward flat end of Goose.



3. *Creating corner 4-patch:* Attach Green strips to Gold strips, pressing toward Green. Place strata face to face...butting seams really carefully...and having opposite colors together. Trim one end square by setting a line on your ruler on the seam line and cutting end. Then cut 4 1-1/2" units. Stitch each unit together...to get center seams really tight...set unit with the "edge" of the upper seam allowance pointing toward the presser foot as this will slightly "push" the butted seams together when stitching. Press either way. Square up to 2-1/2".

4. Attach a 4-Goose unit to opposite sides of Print square, using block diagram for placement. Press toward Print square.

5. Attach a 4-patch to both ends of last 4-Goose units, using block diagram for placement. Press toward 4-patches.

6. Attach units from step#5 to last 2 sides of Print unit from step#4. Press toward center.
