

**COTTON SPICE BLOCK OF THE MONTH
SIMPLICITY
BLOCK #6**

*designed by Barbara Campbell
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Makes one 8" x 8" block (8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions

1. Cut four 2 1/2" squares of blue and green fabrics
2. Cut two 3" squares of purple and gold fabrics
3. Cut one 4 1/2" square of focus floral fabric

Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each gold fabric square.

Note: It is helpful to use a piece of sandpaper to hold the fabric squares in place while drawing the diagonal line. I have glued a 9" x 12" piece of standard size sandpaper to a sturdy piece of cardboard to use for purposes such as this.

2. Place right sides together with a purple square and stitch 1/4" from either side of the line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press to the darker fabric. Trim each square to measure 2 1/2". Makes four half square triangle blocks.



3. Sew the squares together in three rows as shown in the photograph.



4. Join the rows together to make one block.
